## Country Day Summer Camp 2010 2 and 3 year olds

- All campers must wear closed toed shoes (**sneakers**).
- All Full Day children will need to bring a **cot sheet** (crib size) for rest time. You may wish to send a small **blanket** for a top cover and a **small pillow**.
- **Lunchbox** with a drink for full day campers

### **Arrival and Dismissal**

Arrival: Please park and walk your child to the classroom from **9 to 9:10am**.

Dismissal: Next to Primary 3, **Dismissal:** Half Day 11:50-12:00 and Full Day 2:45-3:00

Please stay in your car for dismissal...we will bring your child to the car.

Due to limited demand, Extended-Care before and after camp is available through special arrangement only.

### **Snacks and Lunch**

The school provides a daily morning snack. Water is always available in the classroom and on the playground. Please send a packed nutritious **lunch with a drink** and an ice pack. Microwaves and stoves are not available for warming food.

### **Wednesday is Water Play Day**

Please bring your child to camp wearing their bathing suit and water shoes. We will play at the water table and under sprinklers. Please send a towel and a full change of clothes, socks and sneakers for the rest of the day.

### **Pony Rides**

Pony rides will be offered once weekly to any full day campers who wish to participate. Please complete the attached Barnyard/Riding form to participate.
